#### **Qualifications for the scholarship:**

- 1) Identify as Black, Indigenous, Latinx, AAPI or other person of color, or as member of the LGBTQIA community
- 2) Be a graduating senior (or equivalent age 16-20) in Delta County
- 3) Looking to pursue post-highschool education or training (technical school, community college, 4 year college, culinary school, apprenticeship, etc.)

*While we do ask that students provide their transcripts, this scholarship will not be awarded based solely on merit & GPA.*
